quickly in danger of sinking, never making it to Australia.

COLOR

Cherry red with purple hues.

BOUQUET

A medley of berry fruits with subtle oak notes.

A vibrant wine with lively juicy berry fruits, subtle spice and supporting oak, across a softly textured medium-full bodied palate. It's smooth, well-rounded and rewarding, with a refined finish. This wine has the generous flavours and balance to mature well over 5 years.
